I am to invite your attention to the references noted above and to inform you that the Hon. Vice-Chancellor has given permission to start the proposed Architecture College during 1984-85 on the conditions mentioned below :

- The conditions laid down by the Govt. of Maharashtra State vide G.R. No. TEN-3382-11836 (190)/TE-1-a dt. 21-5-83 and dt. 6-6-84 and ~~and~~ Director of Technical Education, Bombay mentioned above are applicable to you and adhered to promptly. The copies of the above G.R.s be furnished to this office, immediately, alongwith the report of fulfilling the conditions laid down therein.
 - As per clause IV of the condition laid down by Govt. and accepted by you, you have to deposit an amount of Rs. 10 lakhs by F.D.R. for 61 months in the Joint Account of Management and Director of Technical Education, Maharashtra State, Bombay within ONE MONTH from the date 16-8-1984.
 - You have to charge the fees prescribed as Rs. 4000/- per student per year and total intake capacity for 1st year will be 60 only. The rules and regulations for admission are already supplied to you by Director of Technical Education, Bombay, which may be observed strictly.
 - Please note that the working of the college will have to continue even in Winter Vacation to meet out the short fall due to late beginning of the college.
 - As the portion of study prescribed for Semester I would not be completed before October, 1984 examination and as such the University authorities have decided the students be permitted to appear
